Dear Parent or Guardian:

The regulations for school health examinations, also known as a health appraisal or physicals, have changed effective July 1, 2018. State law requires that each child in a school district have a school health examination, including body mass index, and also *recommends* a complete dental examination prior to entering school. A school health examination is required for grades PreK, Kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, 9th and 11th grade students. These examinations/appraisals may be completed up to one year to the month before your child begins these grades, as an exam is valid for a full year through the last day of the month in which the exam was conducted. Additionally, new entrants to the district, students wishing to play interscholastic sports, and students desiring work permits must have an annual school health examination. Your family physician/nurse practitioner is most familiar with the medical history of your child and is able to start treatment when necessary. Therefore, the district recommends that all examinations be made by your family physician/nurse practitioner. Completed school health examination forms, appraisal or physical forms may be directly mailed or faxed to the school nurse from the provider's office.
